Project Graduation Guidelines and Rules for Students

The parties will be held at the **FRITCHIE PARK GYM**, 905 W. Howze Beach Road, Slidell, LA 70458

Party hours are from 11:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. No one will be admitted before 11:00 p.m. or after midnight. Party dates by high school are: (You may only attend the party for YOUR SCHOOL)

NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR BEVERAGE IS ALLOWED TO BE BROUGHT INTO THE PARTY. (This pertains to adults working the party and students attending the party)

Dress is casual. We encourage the students to wear the Project Graduation T-shirts (included in the pre-admission price) and blue jeans or shorts (school dress code length applicable). A light jacket is advisable, as the facility can get chilly. Students must wear shoes.

Leave your valuables at home or locked safely in the trunk of your vehicles. Students are NOT allowed to leave the party until it is officially “closed” by the Party Chairs and parents have been contacted for “no shows”. Parents/Guardians will be notified if a student who purchased a reservation does not arrive or wishes to leave the party early. Once a student leaves the party, he/she will be unable to return and is no longer eligible for any of the prizes.

Only seniors from the designated high schools will be admitted to their respective party. Project Graduation is a final celebration for the Class of 2020. **(NO DATES/GUESTS/SIBLINGS/CHILDREN, ETC. - NO EXCEPTIONS)**

Unlimited food and drink, entertainment, games and prizes are included in the price of admission. **Admission is \$40 if paid by March 30, 2020.** T-shirts are only ISSUED if paid by March 30th. **T-shirts will be distributed at your school’s graduation picnic or rehearsal as decided by your school’s party chair.** Advanced purchase is highly suggested, however payments can be made at the door - \$50 CASH ONLY. **REFUNDS ARE NOT ISSUED ONCE PAID. Students who pay at the door will not be allowed to enter until 11:30pm and will not receive a t-shirt.**

All prize drawings will be held between 4:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. The graduate must be present to win.

The Slidell Police will provide uniformed security. They will assist with parking, assure against any “party crashing”, and be available for general security. Volunteer security will assist graduates by answering questions, providing directions and securing off-limits areas. Parking will be limited to the front of the park by the baseball fields.

The use of alcohol and/or illegal drugs will not be permitted. **There will be a Zero Tolerance Policy – no one will be admitted if prior use of alcohol and/or illegal drugs is suspected.** The Slidell Police Department and/or the Ambulance Service on site will determine this. Seniors suspected of being under the influence will be isolated and their parents will be called. All decisions to remove a student from the parties will be final and no refunds will be given.

Welcome/check-in will store all personal belongings including: cell phones, car keys, etc. Cameras are permitted however **no bags, purses or backpacks are allowed. Project Graduation is NOT responsible for any items left behind, lost, damaged or stolen (including but not limited to cell phones).** *No video cameras are permitted.* Please do not wear jewelry or bring valuables. **DO NOT BRING:** pillows, sleeping bags, large purses, backpacks, or gaming devices, as we do not have the storage space. Your purchase of a reservation/ticket to the Project Graduation parties, gives us permission to publish your picture in any media format (i.e. website, newspaper, newsletter, Facebook page, etc.).
